For our Term 1 Marine Topic we will be going on the following three local beach field trips listed below:

Henderson Bay - Thursday 7th February.

Rarawa - Wednesday 13th February.

Houhora Heads - Thursday 28th February.

While at these locations we will be conducting species identification and abundance surveys. We will complete a snorkel transect in the water, metre square on the rocks and a beach walk activity. When back at school students will graph and compare the data they collect to last years data.
